This advanced two-day course furthers the knowledge of a practicing industrial hygienist in the application of exposure assessment and statistical concepts and techniques. The goal is to provide the student with the tools needed to manage the often intimidating task of evaluating and prioritizing chemical exposure assessments and interpreting industrial hygiene data in a statistical and defensible manner. Some industrial hygiene experience is an essential prerequisite, and some previous statistics coursework is helpful. However, the potentially complex concepts are described and practiced in a manner to equip the student with the knowledge and confidence to apply the skills that are learned. Traditional as well as innovative and practical approaches are discussed, with many opportunities for class participation and numerous hand-on exercises. A laptop with Microsoft Excel software is recommended.

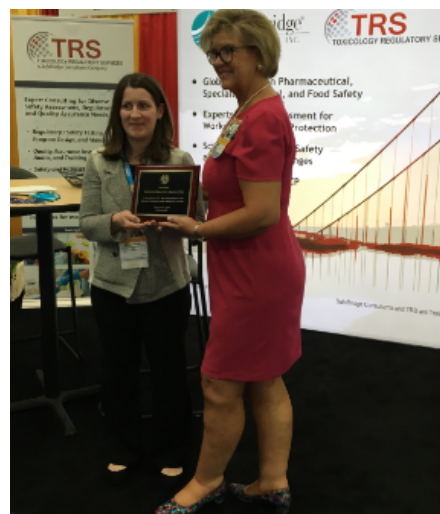
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Toxicology Awards and Achievements

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SafeBridge Laboratory Announces Development of Three Sensitive Air Sampling and Analytical Methods

The SafeBridge analytical laboratory continues to develop the most sensitive methods in the industry for analyzing active pharmaceutical ingredients (APIs) for industrial hygiene purposes.

SafeBridge's AIHA-LAP accredited laboratory has developed an industrial hygiene air sampling and analytical method for the following APIs:

- Amifostine: limit of quantification is 0.5 mcg/sample
- Carbetocin: limit of quantification is 5 ng/sample
- Esuberaprost: limit of quantification is 2 ng/sample

These limits of quantification, using LC/MS/MS technology, allow for monitoring of short duration operations to meet current low Occupational Exposure Limits (OELs) for these APIs in the industry. An air sampling method summary providing information on sampling media, flow rate and storage conditions is available.
